



## HRT 2010 Race Season Volunteer Sign-Up Sheet

It takes an army of volunteers each race day to keep the races moving in a timely fashion. Beginning this year, we are assigning two weekends to each HRT racing family to work during the season. Each family is asked to provide a family member for the races assigned. This volunteer can be any *responsible* member of your family; this person does not need to be a skier. Attached is a brief description of the jobs that need to be filled on a weekly basis and what they entail. We will provide training for all of the positions prior to the first race. **Please don't be intimidated**-working a race will allow you to understand and enjoy the world of ski racing!

We ask that you fill out the Volunteer Sign-Up sheet and return it with your registration packet. If we do not receive it with your packet, we will assume that you have no race preferences. We will make every effort to accommodate your choices. If you are unable to meet your race commitments, it is your responsibility to coordinate with another family to provide coverage. By delegating the responsibilities in this manner we will be able to meet our weekly needs and have an appropriate number of volunteers. A master schedule for the season will be posted in the race room prior to the first race.

Registration – will need to arrive 20min prior to team check-in; need two (2) volunteers

- Set up registration table
- Check racers in/hand out bibs
- Close registration and make copies of lineup

Leader Board – need two (2) volunteers

- Set up/tear down easel at finish shack
- Make adjustments to lineup from registration
- Write results as announced on score sheets

Finish Shack Crew – need three (3) volunteers

- Record racer time off display onto score sheets-one volunteer for each course
- Announcer – announce racers and finish times

Race Room – need one (1) volunteer

- Put together ribbons and get to coaches
- Collect bibs from racers, put in numerical order and store
- Ensure race room is clean and storage closet locked

Gate Keepers – need six (6) volunteers

- Three keepers for each course

Starters – need four (4) volunteers

- One volunteer at the start chute for each course
- One volunteer to do racer lineup for each course
